APPLICATION FOR SUBMISSION OF NAME TO THE MISSOURI EMS MEMORIAL SERVICE WALL:

Our Mission: The Missouri EMS Memorial Foundation and the Missouri EMS Memorial was established with one purpose; honoring the memory of Missouri Emergency Medical Services individuals who gave their lives in the line of duty. We are dedicated to providing a permanent home where individuals, families, and organizations can go to reflect and remember their loved ones who gave that ultimate sacrifice.

The Memorial: Located at Missouri Western State University, in the City of St. Joseph, a memorial site was selected to erect a permanent memorial. The Missouri EMS Memorial Wall will serve as a tribute to immortalize the extraordinary commitment and courage of the State of Missouri's EMS Providers. We also recognize the need to honor those who have faithfully served in EMS. Those names may be etched in to one of the Service Walls which flank the Memorial Wall. Thus, watching over our fallen comrades.

To qualify for inclusion on a Memorial Service Wall the following criteria should be met:

- An individual who has served a minimum of ten year in the EMS profession with conclusion of their service in a State of Missouri Agency in good standing.
- EMS Professionals not meeting the 10 year requirement, under extraordinary circumstances, may be considered on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the current Board of Directors. For this to occur the application should be completed and include a letter stating as much detail as possible about the individual's circumstances and a minimum of three letters of recommendation. These applications do not guarantee inclusion on the Missouri EMS Memorial.
- Individuals whom have shown superior dedication to the EMS Profession in the State of Missouri may be considered on a case-by-case basis with approval of the current Board of Directors. This may include, but not limited to, individuals who have served as a local/state advisor, medical director, or educator. For this to occur the application should be completed and with it a minimum of three letters of recommendation submitted. These applications do not guarantee inclusion on the Missouri EMS Memorial.

Application Process: Applications must be completed and submitted to the Missouri EMS Memorial Foundation before April 1 for inclusion in that year's Memorial Service. This shall include as much supporting documentation that you feel will aid the Board of Directors in the process selection for inclusion on the wall. If possible, the potential honoree should be sponsored by a Missouri EMS Agency which shall also act as the point-of-contact between the Missouri EMS Memorial Foundation and the Next of Kin. If a sponsor is not available the "Department Liaison" section can be completed by any individual whom is willing to aid in the process such as clergy, or past coworker/partner. Applications shall include a check of \$150, made out to "Missouri EMS Memorial Foundation," which will be processed upon acceptance for inclusion at the Missouri EMS Memorial. Denied applications will have this check returned. Space available is limited to one line of text, with a maximum of 25 characters, which shall include the honoree's name, years served & role served. On the web site it will also include department served and location at the memorial.
